

Advent: A season of Hope and joy.

Dear fellow believers in Christ, it is hard to believe that Christmas is less than a month away. We find ourselves in the beginning of the new church year – Advent. Advent means arrival. The arrival of our Lord is imminent – The Lord of Lords who was born on a chaotic night in the little town of Bethlehem in a little animal shelter. The Advent season is a time of waiting; a time of listening and a time of preparation for the coming of our Lord.

Waiting is not always easy. Imagine waiting for 400 year. 400 years spans the gap between the prophet Malachi who promised that God will send the Messiah and the arrival of the Son of God. 400 years of waiting and silence from God. For this reason we to can join in with our watchword for December and also so shout:

"Shout for joy, you heavens; rejoice, you earth; burst into song, you mountains! For the Lord comforts his people and will have compassion on his afflicted ones" Isaiah 49:13

May each one of you experience Christ peace in your hearts and homes this Christmas! May you experience God's blessing in the New Year and remember his promise to us whatever may come: GOD WITH US!

News from the Bishop's desk

Food for Thought

"Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some people have entertained angels without knowing it." Hebrews 13:2 This scripture was a guiding verse for our Joint Reformation Day service in Athlone. We often have visitors in our congregations, homes and in many daily encounters. But how can we see the opportunities given in meeting strangers? I would like to suggest 3 R's:

- 1. Return visits invite the strangers in such a way that they want to be back and be part of the body of Christ.
- 2. **Relationships** built meaningful relationships. It is not always easy but that is what we are about. God has created us as relational beings.
- 3. **Responsibility** help them to find their gifting and ministry so that they serve in, with and for the body of Christ that lives to His glory, instead of just being there as a new member.

News from the Circuit Conferences and Congregations

Circuit Conference East

- a. Coastal Parish. Pastor HP von Fintel has started his ministry in the parish on 1 October. He will be inducted as pastor of the parish on 29 November at St. Andrew's in East London. We wish him and the congregation God's richest blessing for the journey together
- b. Friedenskirche in Port Elizabeth. Pastor Anja Spiske has start with her ministry on 1 November. She will be inducted as pastor of the congregation on 13 December 2015. We wish her and the congregation God's richest blessing for the journey together.
- c. The Inland Parish congregations are still vacant The Regional Church in Hannover has agreed to advertise this post in December, which will hopefully result in pastors from that region to showing their interest so that we will be able to fill the post by September 2016. Let us carry these congregations in our prayers.

Pastor em. Arthur Becker has agreed to assist during the vacancy as from February 2016.

d. The Dawn congregation has taken a decision to close the congregation, starting with the process of selling the property. We wish

the Congregational Council and all members God's guidance in this process and trust that they will soon find a spiritual home in one of the neighbouring congregations.

Circuit Conference West

- a. The St Martini congregation has elected Pastor Dr. Claudia Nolte-Schamm as their pastor. They are currently engaging with her when she will start her ministry.
- Pastor Siegfried Hambrock will retire at the end of June 2016.
- We wish all involved wisdom, peace and guidance in the presence of the Holy Spirit.
- b. Pastor Jens Warnke was after a long process unsuccessful to obtain a visa to serve for an extended period of three year. This means that the Southern Cape Congregation is vacant. We thank him and his family for their dedicated service and wish them God's blessing for the ministry in Germany.

ELCSA(NT) Synod

The Synod of the ELCSA(N-) has adopted a motion to continue to prepare a possible merger following the same time frame as adopted by our Synod in King Williams Town. The congregations will be kept informed as we prepare for the synods in2017
